PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION

- A minimum of 16 credits (including Language Arts 12) must be at the Grade 12 level. This does not include the 4 credits for Graduation Portfolio.
- All students are required to take either a Fine Arts or an Applied Skills course.

EXTERNAL CREDITS

- A student receives Language 10 credit if he completes grade 7 in his home country. (4 credits)
- A student receives Language 11 credit if he completes grade 8 in his home country. (4 credits)
- A student receives Language 12 credit if he completes grade 9 in his home country. (4 credits)

GRADUATION PROGRAM EXAMS

- Students must write province-wide "Graduation Program Exams" in the following courses:
 - Language Arts 10
 - Science 10
 - Mathematics 10
 - Socials Studies 11
 - Language Arts 12
- The grade 10 and 11 provincial exams will account for 20% of the final letter grade.
- The Language Arts 12 provincial exam will account for 40% of the final letter grade.
- Post secondary institutions continue to require students to take the exams for all examinable courses as an entrance requirement.
